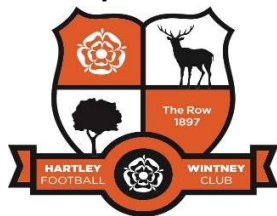


Hartley Wintney FC Risk Assessment 2020/2021: COVID TRAINING & MATCH SPECIFIC

<p>Attending Training/Match Players will be given basic instruction of the measures put in place by the Club.</p>	<p>Each player is given a Covid Return to training and match declaration form. This form is signed and returned to the Club and held on file.</p> <p>On arrival at the ground each player will have their temperature taken. If this is in excess of 37.5 the player will be asked to leave and seek medical advice</p> <p>A Track & Trace register is completed and held on file.</p>	medium

Physical injuries	Coaching Staff to have first aid training qualification. Dehydration/Exhaustion	Players to provide their own water bottles to avoid potential cross contamination	low	
Travelling to training	Travelling to training is at the discretion of the individual and should be in accordance with Government Guideline	low	Players/coaches responsible for their own travel arrangements
Access to changing Rooms	Access will be granted only to access equipment necessary for session. Access to changing areas to be controlled by both home and away teams to maintain social distancing measures. Consider changing in shifts. Windows and doors will remain open to assist with airflow. Changing rooms will be watched by steward for security purposes	Low	All training protocols to follow Government guidelines
